What measures will Rosslyn Park implement to safeguard your child and your family?

Action	Safeguards in Place
<p>Pupil Attendance</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only children with a confirmed place can attend • Children without a confirmed place will not be allowed in the school building • If your child has a continuous cough and/or high temperature and/or loss of smell and taste they must not come to school and you have to call 111 to discuss potential testing • Early collection of children is strongly discouraged and can only be done so with prior arrangement. • School will be CLOSED on Wednesday to all but Key Worker/Vulnerable children in order to be deep cleaned.
<p>Pupil Arrival</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will arrive at different times to avoid too many arriving at once • No more than 1 parent per child/family • One-way system in place all around school • Children will wash their hands regularly throughout the day – arrival, break time, before lunch, after lunch, home time • No lining up outside as children will go straight into their classroom • Children MUST NOT play on the outdoor equipment and should remain 2m away from other children/families • NO CHILD should be in school if symptomatic, they will be isolated immediately and sent home • Children will not wear PPE in school
<p>School Staff</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child will be taught in a small group – “bubble” of up to 9 children • We will endeavour to keep the same staff with your child • Staff will communicate with parents via Class Dojo and phone calls when needed as no parents are allowed in the classrooms • All appointment must be made in advance however these are strongly discouraged • Office staff will allow 1 parent at a time at the school reception • Staff will have access to PPE when required
<p>Classroom</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will sit on a single table which will be 2m away from others • It will be the same table daily for each child

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will have a tray on their desk with all the resources they need for the day • Children’s coat, bag, lunchbox will be kept at their table • Children will be expected to follow the school and social distancing rules • Children are NOT allowed to bring any additional items from home, such as, but not limited to, toys, pencil cases and mobile phones. • Children may bring a sun hat with them and sun cream, when needed, should be applied before coming to school. • Children will be given new water bottles on arrival – They must take them home and bring their own with them each day. • Behaviour Expectations will be clearly displayed
<p>Behaviour</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be an update to the way we expect your child to behave in school to reflect our school moto to keep everybody safe: “Keep 2m apart-Stay in your bubble-Wash your hands” • If your child does not follow school rules and put other children at risk, you will be asked to collect them • Coughing deliberately and spitting are now serious breaches of our school behaviour expectations and likely to result in exclusion
<p>Break</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will wash their hands before and after play time • Children will remain in their small group and not mix with the others • Children will play in a designated space to keep them away from other groups • All games will be FUN but will be non-contact games • No tuck shop will be available – Snacks will be provided for all children free of charge.
<p>Lunch</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be NOT be a hot lunch available and children will be provided with a packed lunch. • Children may bring in their own packed lunch if they prefer, which they will keep at their table. • Children will have their lunch in their classroom on their designated table • Children will wash their hands before and after lunch time • Children will be looked after by a midday supervisor
<p>First Aid/Child with Symptoms</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be a designated First Aider on site, who will wear gloves, apron and a face mask when applying first aid • If children develop symptoms such as continuous cough and/or high temperature and/or loss of smell and taste at school they will be moved to an isolation room and you will be asked to collect them immediately

<p>Cleaning through the day</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cleaners will be onsite throughout the day to clean surface and touch points• Toilets will be cleaned regularly• Anti-bacterial wipes will be regularly used to wipe down touch points in classroom
<p>Home Time</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children will leave at different times to avoid too many leaving at once• No more than 1 parent per child/family to collect• One-way system in place all around school• Children and families must leave the school premises immediately
