Home Learning

Dear Parents/Carers,

Firstly a huge thanks to all parents and carers who have supported us by following the guidance whilst dropping off and collecting their children. The cooperation of parents has ensured that we have been able to support the smooth and safe return of children onto the school site.

As you will have seen from previous letters we have continued to increase the number of children in school and currently have pupils from Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. We intend to invite all statutory year groups into school for at least 4 days before the end of term. If your child is in Year 2, 3 or 4 we will be sending out further information in the coming days about dates and arrangements for pupils coming into school. It has been wonderful seeing so many children and parents back on the school premises and we look forward to seeing more of you before the end of term.

For those children who are still not attending school we have noticed a significant reduction in the level of engagement in Home Learning. Staff are still setting work for children to complete each week and communicating via Class Dojo. Please ensure you respond to these messages weekly and the work set where possible. This allows us to know what support the children need and how best we can help. If teachers do not receive any contact via Class Dojo or the other online learning tools we are using I have asked them to contact you via phone to see what else we can do to help. Please be aware that if we are unable to contact you this may be referred to the Safeguarding team and followed up by a home visit.

We know that this has been a very challenging time for both children and parents and we do not want to put parents or children under undue pressure however we would still like the children to engage as much as possible. We now know that the intention of the Government is to have all pupils back in September and we want the children to be as prepared as possible. Additionally, we are also hoping to see all children, including those not attending, before the end of the academic year and will soon be in touch with further details.
