<p>Pupil Attendance</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School will be open all week. • Attendance at school is compulsory – if you have any concerns please discuss them with us. • If your child has a continuous cough and/or high temperature and/or loss of smell and taste they must not come to school and you have to call 111 to discuss potential testing • Early collection of children is strongly discouraged and can only be done so with prior arrangement. If you have children in different year groups please make sure you have let us know.

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<p>School Staff</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will work predominantly with children from their own class and avoid working with other classes where possible. • We will endeavour to keep the same staff with your child however staff can move between classes as long as safety measures are followed. • Staff will communicate with parents via Class Dojo and phone calls when needed as we discourage parents coming into classrooms. • All appointment must be made in advance so that appropriate safety measures can be put in place. • Office staff will allow 1 parent at a time at the school reception • Staff will have access to personal protective equipment where necessary.
<p>Classroom</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will sit on a table with a partner with all tables facing forward – this will not be the case in Nursery, Reception or Year 1. • It will be the same table daily for each child. • Children will have their own set of resources that they will not share with others. • Children will be expected to follow the school and social distancing rules. • Children are NOT allowed to bring any additional items from home, such as, but not limited to, toys, pencil cases and mobile phones. • Children may bring a sun hat with them and sun cream, when needed, should be applied before coming to school. • Behaviour Expectations will be clearly displayed
<p>Behaviour</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be an update to the way we expect your child to behave in school to reflect our school moto to keep everybody safe: “Keep 2m apart-Stay in your bubble-Wash your hands” • Coughing deliberately and spitting are now serious breaches of our school behaviour expectations and likely to result in exclusion
<p>Break</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will wash their hands before and after play time • All games will be FUN but will be non-contact games • No tuck shop will be available. We will provide a piece of fruit or a snack each day for all children.
<p>Lunch</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will return to serving hot dinners which can be ordered through the School Gateway app. • Children may bring in their own packed lunch if they wish. • Reception and Year1 will eat their dinner in the Hall. • Year 2 to Year 6 will eat their lunches in the classroom – if they ordered a hot dinner it will be served to them there.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children will wash their hands before and after lunch time• Children will be looked after by a midday supervisor
First Aid/Child with Symptoms 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Designated First Aiders will be on site, who will wear gloves, apron and a face mask when applying first aid• If children develop symptoms such as continuous cough and/or high temperature and/or loss of smell and taste at school they will be moved to an isolation room and you will be asked to collect them immediately
Cleaning through the day 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cleaners will be onsite throughout the day to clean surface and touch points• Toilets will be cleaned regularly• Anti-bacterial wipes will be regularly used to wipe down touch points in classroom
