Dear Parents/Carers,

I just wanted to say a huge thank you for supporting us in getting the children back to school safely and successfully. Our attendance has been above 95% for the first three days back and we have been delighted to see so many happy and smiling faces.

The children have shown how resilient they are and have settled back into their routines with brand new teachers like ducks to water. We have had the odd difficulty, lunchtimes have proved to be a logistical challenge, however the midday supervisors and kitchen staff have done a fantastic job in getting everything organised.

As you will have seen in my previous letter our biggest challenge has been getting pupils safely in and out of school. We are a very large school and need to try and reduce the number of parents on site at any one time. We recognise that the one way system is an inconvenience however we also know that it is an important factor in reducing contact between children and parents. We need your cooperation to make this work. Myself, and my staff do not have the capacity to be at the gate each and every day although we will be out as often as we can. We are relying on parents and families to follow the signs and it has been great to see that the vast majority of parents have done this. We will be reviewing our risk assessment weekly and if we can find alternative measures we will introduce these.

Thank you again for such a successful first week. We know that there will be many challenges ahead but together we can keep each other safe and ensure the children receive the education they deserve.
